Since its first edition back in 2016, the EurOPDX Workshop has been a unique opportunity to meet and exchange with world-renowned experts in the field of preclinical oncology using PDX models and other patient-derived models.

To get the most from your two days in Egmond aan Zee, we encourage you to submit an abstract to promote your research and foster discussions with other attendees. Abstracts will be selected by the Scientific Committee according to scientific excellence. One abstract in each session, from a PhD student or Postdoc only, will be invited for a short talk scheduled within the main programme at the end of each session, and will also qualify for a travel award; the remaining abstracts will be allocated to present in poster format. Several poster prizes will also be awarded.

Your abstract should be submitted in one of the following **4 topics, linked to the workshop programme**:

- "PDX model initiatives, collections and standards" (establishment and validation of novel PDX models (subcutaneous), studies using these PDX models to advance knowledge in oncology and cancer precision medicine, standards in the field)
- "Advances in in vitro/ex vivo platforms for drug screening" (*in vitro/ex vivo* patient-derived models)
- "Humanised & Orthotopic PDX models"
- "Open submission", if none of the topics above fits.

Abstract content guidelines:

To be considered, an abstract should meet to the following guidelines:

- Must be submitted in **good English**. The Scientific Committee reserves the right to reject abstracts which are presented in poor English, or may request an immediate revision by the presenter.
- Abstract titles should be brief and should reflect the content of the abstract.
- Commercial names may not be used in the abstract title.
- No more than 10 authors can be listed. Only institutional affiliations, cities, and countries should follow.
- Abstracts should be organised under the headings:
 - Introduction
 - Material and methods
 - Results and discussion
 - Conclusion
- We will **not** accept abstracts that exceed **2,900 characters** (including spaces).
- Abbreviations may be used if standard or if spelled out and defined at their first use. Compounds should be mentioned with the generic name, in lower cases. Commercial names are allowed in the text, noted with an ®, and if in brackets following the generic name, i.e. "generic (Commercial ®)".
- Supplementary data or appendices will not be accepted.

- Figures or photographs are not allowed. Symbols and structures of drugs are allowed and should be drawn in black.
